


SELECTING YOUR COURSES

YEAR 9 OPTION COURSES FOR 2019

- 1. Year 9 students are required to choose **FOUR** half-year option courses, **including a language** other than English, and two back-up courses.
- 2. It may be appropriate for a small number of students who have additional literacy needs to receive literacy support rather than opting for a language other than English.
- 3. We encourage students to choose from a broad range of options in Year 9 and Year 10, and specialising later in their secondary education.
- 4. Students who are identified with special abilities will be offered entry into the GATE programme Learning Enrichment Option (09LEO) and/or Sports Performance (09SPX). Each course will be taken in place of another option. Students cannot take Sports Performance (09SPX) and 09 Sports Studies (09SPS) in the same year.









JAPANESE	09ЈАР


SPANISH	09SPA


TE REO MĀORI	09МĀО


